Gainesville High School Prom 2024 Dance Form

We are excited to have you attend Prom on April 13, 2024! Prom will be held at the Hylton Performing Arts Center from 7-11pm. The theme is “Masquerade Ball.” This dance form has been made to ensure that all students understand the expectations, as well as help us ensure that all students receive a paper ticket. Students are encouraged to bring a photo ID with them to the dance.

Tickets Sales: Red Commons (all lunches) **SENIORS ONLY 3/18-3/20 and 3/22.** TICKET SALES OPEN TO ALL JUNIORS AND SENIORS 4/1 – 4/5

Ticket Cost: \$55 per ticket, cash or check

Outside Guest Information: Each GHS student is allowed to bring one outside guest to Prom. The dance is limited to those students in high school or who have completed high school. Outside guests must be under the age of 21 (born after April 13, 2003). The GHS student must accompany their guest to the dance. A separate outside guest form must be completed and submitted for the outside guest to be able to attend. Forms can be picked up in the main office and outside room 2106. Outside guest forms are due at ticket purchase.

Dance Expectations:

- Attendees may only access areas designated by the chaperones.
- Appropriate social behavior will be expected of all attendees. All school rules and expectations for appropriate behavior apply, including those pertaining to drugs, alcohol, and tobacco use. Students suspected of being under the influence of drugs/alcohol will be held until a parent or guardian picks them up. If a parent/guardian cannot be found, the student will be turned over to the police.
- There will be no re-entry – once a student enters the dance they must remain in the dance and if they choose to leave, they will not be allowed to return.
- Dance movements and mannerisms must fall within the standards of social acceptability and good taste. Dancing or movements, which depict private acts, are sexually suggestive, or are a distraction to others, are not allowed. Feet should be on the floor at all times, while hands should not be on the floor. Physically dangerous dancing such as slamming or moshing is not allowed.
- Attendance at a school dance is considered a privilege, not a right. Administration reserves the right to deny admittance to any student.

Dress Code: Students who attend Prom must be properly dressed to be admitted. The dress code is formal dress.
