



GHS CIP – Current State

- Each year, schools in our division complete a comprehensive needs assessment to develop a Continuous Improvement Plan that aligns with the PWCS Strategic Plan.
- Each plan identifies a Theory of Action and Impact & Implementation Goal(s) for Learning and Achievement for All, Positive Climate and Culture, and Family & Community Engagement commitments.

- 1. Using literacy strategies strong models of co-planning and co-teaching to improve SOL scores among SWD and EL students:
 - In Algebra I from 80% to 85% for SWD, and 82% to 85% for EL
 - In Biology I from 54% to 85% for SWD, and 45% to 85% for EL
 - In Reading from 85% to 86% for SWD, and 76% to 85% for EL
- 2. Use MTSS systems to tier supports for a focused group of students to:
 - Reduce Chronic Absenteeism by 1.2%, and remain below 15% for the 2024-25 SY
- 3. Family and Community Engagement
 - Maintain inclusive membership within our P.A.C. and align meeting dates and agendas with the Continuous Improvement and Budget cycles for feedback and input

Learning and Achievement for All

- Increase Reading, Biology, and Algebra I SOL test pass rates among EL and SWD to 85%
- 23-24 SOL Overall Pass Rates: 90.5% in Reading, 86.5% in Biology, and 90.1% in Algebra I

Theory of Action 1

- If we implement professional learning for and monitor the regular and ongoing deployment of literacy strategies (explicit vocabulary instruction, write converse write, clearer stronger, reciprocal teaching, and academic discourse) across content areas (EB) Then, teachers will plan for and deploy literacy strategies in their classrooms with greater frequency, which will allow students to more frequently engage in reading, writing, and speaking tasks to build up ideas and increase proficiency in the content which will result in increased SOL scores of SWD and EL:
 - In Algebra I from 80% to 85% for SWD, and 82% to 85% for EL
 - In Biology I from 54% to 85% for SWD, and 45% to 85% for EL
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Theory of Action 2

- If teachers use performance data to identify specific student areas for growth and co-plan to deploy specially designed instruction (SDI) aligned with these areas of focus, then, teachers will deploy coteaching models that use specially designed instruction, increasing intensity of support and feedback,, and students will be able to use practice with feedback to support their own learning, which will result in increased SOL scores of SWD and EL to:
 - In Algebra I from 82% to 85% for SWD, and 82% to 85% for EL
 - In Biology I from 54% to 85% for SWD, and 45% to 85% for EL
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Positive Climate and Culture

- Rates of chronic absenteeism will remain below 15% during the 2024-25 school year
- Gainesville had a 14.92% Chronic Absentee Rate (CAR) in 2023-2024.

Theory of Action

• If we utilize a Student Support Team (SST) to identify a focused group of students and deploy systems of support involving stakeholders, parents, and other positive interventions, then, staff will implement specialized systems of support, and students will experience increased feelings of belonging, improved parent engagement, and increased academic and behavioral support, which will lead to reduced chronic absenteeism from 16.2% to be at or below 15%.



Family and Community Engagement

• Continue to build Principal's Advisory Council membership and purpose to support budget and continuous improvement planning.

Theory of Action

• If GHS leaders implement all 12 High Functioning PAC indicators, then, Gainesville High School's PAC will provide opportunity for community members to provide feedback and be involved in decision-making around school budget and CIP, which will lead to continuing to have a high functioning PAC.

GHS Continuous Improvement Strategies



- Learn and use **literacy** (reading, writing, and academic discourse) techniques and deploy them across curriculum areas (reading and writing)
- Enhance **co-teaching practices** across the curriculum
- Continue to build **tiers of supports** for students to be successful throughout the year.
